

Sporting Clays is a challenging clay target game designed to simulate field shooting. On a Sporting Clays course, shooters are presented with a wide variety of targets that duplicate the flight path of gamebirds, such as flushing, crossing, incoming and other angling shots. Courses are laid out in natural surroundings and typically include five or 10 shooting stations with shooters moving from one station to the next to complete the course. Each station presents shooters with a different type of shot for example, shooters might face flushing "birds" that zip in and out of the trees. Most courses make use of natural features such as woods and ponds to create a realistic setting for each type of shot. This kind of shooting has expanded worldwide and is recognized as not only a system for teaching shooting skills, but also as a tournament sport and one of the major recreational target shooting sports. Participation in sporting clays tournaments is growing faster than any other competitive shooting sport as well as there are the international competition which has been certified by the Federation Internationale de Tir Aux Sportives de Chasse (FITASC)
