

Shooting Ranges Regulations Skeet Trap Shooting Association of Thailand

- 1. A registration in the timetable is required prior to shooting
- 2. It's the responsibility of chief range officers to maximize the use of the ranges according to the registered timetables.
- 3. The solo practice can be allowed only when the range is available and no other members waiting to use the range as indicated in the timetables.

RANGE SAFETY RULES

- 1. TREAT EVERY GUN AS IF IT WERE LOADED AT ALL TIMES.
- 2. NEVER HANDLE ANOTHER PERSON'S GUN WITHOUT PERMISSION.
- 3. NEVER POINT A GUN AT ANYONE WHETHER THE WEAPON IS LOADED OR NOT.
- 4. WHEN CARRYING A GUN, ENSURE THAT THE BREECH IS OPEN AND THE CHAMBER IS CLEAR.
 - 5. BEFORE LOADING, CHECK FOR CORRECT TYPE OF AMMUNITION.

- 6. LOAD AND CLOSE THE GUN ONLY AT A FIRING POSITION.
- 7. BETWEEN FIRING POSITIONS, CARRY THE GUN WITH THE BREECH OPEN.
- 8. FIRE ONLY TOWARDS THE TARGET AREA.
- 9. IF A GUN MISFIRES, KEEP WEAPON POINTED TOWARDS TARGET AREA AND CALL FOR HELP.
- 10. PLACE A GUN ON A RACK WITH ITS MUZZLE POINTING UPWARDS AND THE BREECH OPEN.
